CALL FOR YOUNG INVESTIGATORS AT IFIT 2018

Highly motivated young investigators are kindly invited to apply for short term training periods including the attendance of IFIT 2018.

A total of 5 grants has been secured through the **ACRI "YOUNG INVESTIGATOR TRAINING PROGRAM 2017** http://www.acri.it/

Training period will be spent at the following partner universities:

- University of UDINE,
- University of Cassino and South Latium,
- Politecnico di Torino

Each grant provides up to **3,000 Euros** for applicants stably residing in EU countries (4 grants), or up to **4,000 Euros** for applicants stably residing in non EU countries (1 grant).

Eligibility Requirements

- Degree in Engineering
- Age less than 35 years old
- Stably residing outside Italy
- Minimum duration of the training period for 30 days at partner universities
- Training to be completed by 31.12.2018
- Plan to attend IFIT 2018 (preferably with a paper)
- Submission of a training plan with previously agreed research activities

Applications

Applications will be submitted by email to Prof. Alessandro Gasparetto <u>alessandro.gasparetto@uniud.it</u> with indication of the preferred partner university and possible dates for the training period by **10.05.2018**. Each application should include a cv, a short motivation letter, a training plan, and a reference letter.

Evaluation

Evaluation will be worked out looking at motivations, cv, and training plan (preferably with a joint paper publication plan) and it will determine the partner University for training.
